

## Appendix-III

### Learning Plan

A learning plan is an agreement between you and the Field Work Supervisor, which will be formulated after you study the agency you have been placed. It will take into account the time available, the strengths and limitations of the agency, the need of the beneficiaries and other relevant factors influencing the field work process. The learning plan objectives will be based on the objectives of the BSW first year field work objectives.

The plan should include the following.

- 1) Specific objectives in terms of gain in knowledge, skills and attitude
- 2) Tasks that have to be done which will result in the gain in knowledge, skills and attitude.
- 3) The time frame for doing the tasks.
- 4) The methods by which the learning can be shown to have taken place.

This can be either by recording or by discussion with FWS or by both methods.
